Results of referendum to dismiss the President:

- Romania held the referendum to dismiss its president on Sunday. The turnout was 46.13 pct, with a 3 pct margin of error, the Central Electoral Office (BEC) announced at 10 a.m on Monday. These results suggest Basescu survives the recall because the number of voters who cast ballots was short of the required 50 pct turnout threshold needed for the referendum's results to be valid. This latest estimate of turnout includes also some polling stations from abroad. According to BEC 87.55% of those voted opted to dismiss the president and 11.12% voted against the president's ouster.
